RIESLING

Riesling – arguably the greatest white wine variety, often producing the best value wines and unquestionably the most food-versatile wine in the world (able to match the most delicate dish all the way through to spicy Asian cuisines). And yet it remains the most misunderstood at the same time.

Typically, aromatic (fresh citrus blossom, cut flowers, jasmine) and boasting citrus (lemon/lime), lime marmalade flavours – often with some ginger-like spice, but with most finishing crisp and bone-dry - despite the perception they are sweet. Time to revisit – no, seriously.

Now German - that's a whole other story because sweet they indeed (mainly) are but counter-balancing that sweetness is a laser like acidity that acts as the perfect foil to their delectable charms. Germany's greatest gift to the wine world. One taste will transform your senses. You're welcome.

SAUVIGNON BLANC & BLENDS

Sauvignon Blanc took over the world (our part of the world anyway) and no surprise. With our sub-Tropical climate, the exotic tropical fruit salad flavours (passionfruit, lime and guava) surge forward invigorating even the most jaded palate and refreshing with the abundance of natural acidity.

Ageing and/or blending can show the increased textural complexity (Margaret River) and then the Loire Sancerre / Pouilly Fume examples dial back on the more obvious fruits but dial up the complexity and mouthfeel with citrus, gooseberry, elderflower, grassiness through to subtle blackcurrant and smoky notes.

OTHER WHITE VARIETALS & BLENDS

The most eclectic and interesting section on this list for Whites. New discoveries to be made and value to be had. All dry, all incredibly interesting – for the adventurous palates.

From the crisp, crunchy pear (Grigio) to the poached pear & honey (Gris) – same grape but different interpretations. Soave sweeps in with peach, honeydew, Mediterranean herbs and almond savoury notes. Chenin Blanc shows ripe apple, quince and honeyed notes on a textural palate and there's our legendary Hunter Semillon – when aged they take on a lemon, honey/buttered toast character - our greatest gift to the wine world. Gruner Veltliner excites with green apple-skin and pink peppercorn notes bursting with bright acidity and a satisfying mineral texture. Viognier coats the palate with apricot and soft spice textures.

The new 'Mediterranean' varieties – Fiano, Vermentino, Albarino & Assyrtiko – each present with their own unique expressions - zesty lemon/grapefruit flavours into pear and apricot, red citrus verging into exotic stone fruits and hints of almonds, Mediterranean scrub & summer fruits, oyster shell lemony/mandarin goodness – but most with that saline, maritime minerality that elevates them to the status of the ultimate seafood wines.

CHARDONNAY

Rivals Riesling as the greatest White grape. Gone are the days of blowsy, fat Chardonnays with modern Chardonnay now an exercise in 'less is more'. Don't panic though, we've saved up a few deliciously 'old fashioned' examples for the bold lovers (Allandale, La Crème, Cloudy Bay)

With fruit profiles ranging from citrus/apple (Chablis), ruby grapefruit (WA Chard), stone fruits and melon, through to tropical hints and accompanied by some wine-making alchemy - cream, oatmeal, cedar/vanilla and cashew-like flavours – nowadays in harmony with the fruit with no element dominating. Texturally beyond comparison, complex and completely satisfying, Chardonnay now more than ever represents the pinnacle of nature and nurture in the glass. Leave ABC for the classroom.

ORANGE & ROSÉ

Dominated by the pale, dry Rosés of Provence, France - but also the Italian and local examples nowadays demonstrate that Rosé is infinitely suited to our climate, lifestyle and cuisine. Most boast lively cherry-pip, cranberry and strawberry notes, into raspberry and red plums, Mediterranean scrub and often with a saline mineral tang before finishing bone dry and invigorating.

PINOT NOIR

All hail the Queen! No other grape variety invokes the same level of reverence, worship and devotion as does Pinot Noir. Challenging to grow, demanding in the winery – no other variety can present so many obstacles to the winemaker (or consumer) but equally no other variety can touch the soul like Pinot can, when executed to the level at seen on this list.

Feminine, alluring, exotic – Pinot is seductive and beguiling. From fragrant roses to musk and sous bois, with flavours ranging from strawberry, red/black cherry, plums and hints of game, exotic spices, forest-floor and cedar. Medium to full-bodied but with plush, velvety tannins and bright acidity on an expansive palate that can fan out with a flourish. The most food-versatile of all red wines. This list is dominated by Show winners, internationally accorded and local chart toppers.

SYRAH & SHIRAZ

Syrah is what Shiraz is known as in its home in Northern Rhone Valley, France. Here, in the cooler climate, the grape exhibits more 'compact' red/black fruits, elevated spice (white & black pepper), finer tannins and brighter acidity.

Each of the examples in this section – whether labelled Syrah or Shiraz – each share the same bright fruit, spicy lift and inherent elegance that stamps them from their more brash and bold alter-egos below.

Syrah – the Shiraz for warmer weather.

Shiraz – big, bold, brash – 'take no prisoners-style'. This is what Australia has been best known for so why disappoint? These are all unashamedly full-bodied, big boned with high(er) alcohol, riper tannin and softer acidity more or less but that said, most nowadays are leaning towards a more balanced and – dare I say 'sophisticated' style – without compromising 'impact' and sheer concentration of flavour. Shiraz perhaps, speaks more clearly of a sense of place than any other red variety and the examples below clearly 'fly the flag' for their respective regions.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON & FAMILY BLENDS

In reds, if Pinot Noir is The Queen, then it's only fair to introduce The King – step forward Cabernet Sauvignon.

From the Classified 'Growths' of Bordeaux, to the (equally) scarily expensive Napa Valley examples and here at home with the more sensibly-priced examples with Margaret River and Coonawarra dominating, Cabernet (& 'family' in Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot) – rightfully holds its place in the big chair. Whilst not as demure as Pinot, nor as brash and bold as Shiraz, there's something stately about Cabernet.

Definitely needing something substantial by the way of food, to tame those noticeable tannins, Cabernet(s) nonetheless offers deep, luxurious flavours/aromas of blackcurrant, violets, dark chocolate, mint, cedar and sometimes tobacco leaf and dried herbs. Hugely concentrated and yet maintaining elegance and refinement, on a detailed long palate.
